The pricing per semester is as follows:

If you require a payment plan, please talk with our administration. We are happy to work with you.

Tuition costs/fees for shelter and rescue employees and volunteers is \$2500 (for the 3 month program) with written proof of 8+ hours worked per week for at least month leading up to the start of your R.M.R.D.T.A. time with us. Please include reference letters along with time documentation with your application as well.
